

Attitude of Austrian Liberals to Government Bureaucracy, Reforms in Administrative Management and Judicial System of Austria-Hungary in 1860-1888

Abstract: The problems of correlation between ideas of liberalism and bureaucratic apparatus in dualistic Gabsburgs’ Imperium are studied. Bureaucracy influenced greatly Austrian liberalism, but at the same time there was incongruity between Constitutionalism and bureaucratic apparatus inherited from the New Absolutism age. The country was faced with the necessity for administrative reform and formation of new type of civil servants.
