## **The Eurasian Economic Community Customs Union Decrees and Technical Regulations – an Important Step in Turnover and Import of GM Foods**

**Abstract:** The article reveals the main aspects of EurAsEC customs union legislative regulation concerning turnover and import of GM Foods to Russia, Belorussia and Kazakhstan. The article considers the structure of GM Foods import and turnover regulations valid on the territory of the Eurasian Economic Community Customs Union and enacted by nine Decrees and Technical Regulations of the customs union. The author highlights the role of current Russian legislation empowering the Executive Authorities to develop Technical Decrees projects regarding biotechnological goods imported and sold in Russia, Belorussia and Kazakhstan. The issues concerning labeling imported GM foods and the list of the to-be-registered in the customs union GM products are studied.
