

Secular and Church Legislation of Moscow Tsardom at the Beginning of the 17th Century

Key words and phrases: church law; governor of a province R. F. Boborykin; Tambov in 1636; tsar decrees; unified legislation of Moscow Tsardom.

Abstract: The author examined the legislation of the period of construction of a new city-fortress Tambov by R. F. Boborykin, the governor of the province. The stolnik Boborykin was close to Michail Fedorovich, the first tsar of the Romanov dynasty. During the period of “co-reign” he was at the tsar court, participated in the reception of the foreign ambassadors in the Kremlin and was familiar with church and secular law of Moscow Tsardom: Book of the Helmsman (Nomocanons) and Stoglav (The Book of 100 Chapters), secular law – Code of Law by the Tsar Ioann IV (1550) and the Tsar Fedor Ivanovich (1589), 48 decrees of the Tsar Michail Fedorovich, and nobility charters.
