Vocational and Professional English Language Teaching by Means of ICT at Technical University

Abstract: English language learning is an integral part and a key component of professional training of students at technical universities. The problems of teaching English for vocational and professional purposes are increasingly becoming of high priority in the context of implementation of the new generation of Federal State Standards for Higher Professional Education. The authors analyze the goals and methods of teaching English for specific purposes at technical universities. Much attention is paid to applying Information and Communication Technologies in English classes.
