Evolution of Russian Socially Oriented Non-Profit Organizations in 2012 – 2022. Case Study of Southern Regions of the Central Federal District of the Russian Federation

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Abstract: The activities of socially oriented non-profit organizations (SONPOs) complement both commercial activities and the functionality performed by budgetary structures. It is necessary to monitor and analyze trends in the development of non-profit organizations. The accumulated statistics for the eleven-year period allows us to better understand the development vector of the non-profit sector of the Russian Federation based on the identified trends and even make development forecasts. The dynamics of the development of SONPOs in Russia is considered. The emphasis is placed on quantitative and cost indicators. Significant and insignificant correlations are revealed between the parameters characterizing the activities of SONPOs in 2011 – 2024 with an emphasis on non-profit organizations in the southern regions of the Central Federal District of the Russian Federation. It is shown that the development of SONPOs over the studied period was determined by external factors and directions set by the Presidential Grants Fund of the Russian Federation.

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
