

Improving the Mechanism for Ensuring Sustainable Socio-Economic Development of Russian Federation Regions

Abstract: This article examines the main strategic planning documents developed at various levels of government to achieve the priority goals of the Russian Federation. A mechanism for coordinating target indicators in documents developed within the framework of goal-setting, forecasting, planning, and programming at the federal, federal district, and regional levels is proposed. Recommendations are developed to improve the mechanism for ensuring sustainable socio-economic development of Russian regions. To reduce imbalances between the constituent entities of the Russian Federation, practical recommendations have been proposed, such as the introduction of “basic”, “current”, and “adjustable” indicators for regional social monitoring in the monitoring of programmatic implementation, as well as recommendations for increasing the sustainability of socioeconomic development for various types of regions in the Russian Federation.
